## **FOREWORD**

This Malaysian Standard was prepared by the Technical Committee on Papers and Paper Products under the authority of the Material and Chemical Industry Standards Committee. It has been approved by the Standards Council, Malaysia.

This Standard incorporates the range of sizes which have been recommended by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO). The ISO Recommendation covers two ranges of trimmed sizes based on a logical system already adopted in the national standards of many countries. The main advantage of this system is that every size in the principal and subsidiary ranges has the same proportions and this facilitates enlargement or reduction of the trimmed material by photographic means.
