## **FOREWORD**

This Malaysian Standard was developed by the Working Group on Marine Foods - Fresh and Processed under the authority of the Food and Agricultural Industry Standards Committee.

This Malaysian Standard is the second revision of the Malaysian Standard MS 6 which was published in 1984. A number of modifications have been made in this edition. They are as follows :

- i) the title has been amended from 'frozen' to 'Quick-frozen';
- ii) western style of product presentation had been deleted and has incorporated the product presentation commercially practised by the industry.

In the development of this standard the following publications were referred to :

- a) Information obtained from manufacturers involved in this industry.
- b) Code of Practice of frozen cooked prawns published by the Ministry of Health (1980).

This revised Malaysian Standard is intended to supersede the Malaysian Standard MS 6 : 1984.
