## **FOREWORD**

This Malaysian Standard was developed by the Technical Committee on Animal Feeding Stuffs under the authority of the Food and Agricultural Industry Standards Committee.

This Malaysian Standard is the third revision of MS 226, *Specification for cereal grains (maize) as animal feed stuffs*

Major modifications in this revision are as follows:

- a) deletion of barley from the cereal grain list; and
- b) deletion of T2 toxin and falling number from the characteristic list.

This Malaysian Standard cancels and replaces MS 226:1997
