## **FOREWORD**

This Malaysian Standard was developed by the Technical Committee on Animal Feeding Stuffs under the authority of the Agricultural Industry Standards Committee.

This Malaysian Standard is the fourth revision of MS 20 *Specification for poultry feeds*.

Major modifications in this revision are as follows:

- a) amendments on the types of feed in clause 3;
- b) amendments on the data in Table 1 and Table 2; and
- c) addition of Arginine in Table 1.

This Malaysian Standard cancels and replaces MS 20:1999.
