FOREWORD

This Malaysian Standard was developed by the Technical Committee on Pulp, Paper and Board under the authority of the Industry Standards Committee on Chemicals and Materials.

This Malaysian Standard is the first revision of MS 18, *Specification for toilet tissue paper*.

Major modifications in this revision are as follows:

- a) incorporation of a new clause on “Normative references”;
- b) incorporation of the corresponding MS ISO standards in Table 2. Physical requirements;
and
- c) deletion of Appendices A, B and C.

This Malaysian Standard cancels and replaces MS 18:1971.
