## NATIONAL FOREWORD

The adoption of the ISO Standard as a Malaysian Standard was recommended by the Technical Committee on Tourism and Related Services under the authority of the Industry Standards Committee on Tourism, Exhibition and Hospitality Services.

This Malaysian Standard is identical with ISO 11107:2009, *Recreational diving services - Requirements for training programmes on enriched air nitrox (EAN) diving*, published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO). However, for the purposes of this Malaysian Standard, the following apply:

- a) in the source text, "this International Standard" should read "this Malaysian Standard";
- b) the comma which is used as a decimal sign (if any), to read as a point;
- c) addition of a statement "and to a maximum of 40% oxygen content" in the definition in clause 3.5; and
- d) reference to International Standards should be replaced by corresponding Malaysian Standards as follows:
