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FOREWORD

This Malaysian Standard was developed by the Technical Committee on Sweeteners and Related Products under the authority of the Food and Agricultural Industry Standards Committee.

This Malaysian Standard is the third revision of MS 4, *Specification for white refined sugar for general use*.

Major modifications in this revision are as follows:

- a) the title has been changed to *White refined sugar for general use – Specification*;
- b) definition of white refined sugar has been amended to include polarisation limit;
- c) deletion of “copper” from the requirement, as in Table 1; and
- d) requirements for moisture and sulphur dioxide level has been amended, as in Table 1.

This revised Malaysian Standard cancels and replaces MS 4:1990, *Specification for white refined sugar for general use (Second revision)*.
