FOREWORD

This Malaysian Standard was developed by the Technical Committee on Sweeteners and Related Products under the authority of the Food and Agricultural Industry Standards Committee .

This Malaysian Standard is the third revision of MS 82, *Specification for white refined sugar for industrial use*.

Major modifications in this revision are as follows:

- a) definition of white refined sugar has been amended to include polarisation limit;
- b) deletion of "copper" from the requirement in Table 1; and
- c) the requirement for sulphur dioxide level in Table 1 has been amended.

This Malaysian Standard cancels and replaces MS 82:1989, *Specification for white refined sugar for industrial use (Second revision)*.
